Tae-Sik Park (Gachon University, Republic of Korea)

Tae-Sik Park is a Professor of Life Sciences at Gachon University in Korea. He received his B.A. from Department of Agricultural Chemistry at Korea University in Korea and Ph.D. in Food Science from Rutgers University, USA. He served as a postdoctoral scientist at Pfizer and Columbia University, USA. He was elected as an editorial board member of Journal of Biological Chemistry and Journal of Lipid Research in sphingolipid and phospholipid section. He has worked on the lipidology area since graduate school and he is one of the pioneer linking sphingolipids and cardiovascular diseases. His publications on phospholipids, sphingolipids, cardiovascular intervention, metabolism, and lipidomic have appeared in leading academic journals, including Circulation, Diabetes, Journal of Clinical Investigation, Journal of Biological Chemistry, Journal of Lipid Research, Hepatology, Cell Metabolism, and Gut and Microbe.
