Donna Shu-Han Lin is an interventional cardiologist specializing in coronary and peripheral interventions. Born in 1990, she has devoted her career to the treatment and research of cardiovascular diseases, particularly focusing on areas such as peripheral artery disease, venous thromboembolism, and the impacts of diabetes and chronic kidney disease on cardiovascular health.

Dr. Lin earned her MD degree from National Yang-Ming University, Taipei, in 2015. Currently, Dr. Lin serves as an attending physician in the Division of Cardiology at Shin Kong Wu Ho-Su Memorial Hospital, Taipei, and a lecturer for the Taiwan Ministry of Education. She actively participates in professional societies, contributing to the Taiwan Society of Cardiology, Taiwan Society of Cardiovascular Interventions, Taiwan Myocardial Infarction Society, and the Asian Pacific Society of Cardiology.

Dr. Lin's research focuses on innovative treatments for peripheral artery diseases, the effectiveness of antidiabetic drugs on cardiovascular outcomes, and the intersection of technology with patient care. She is the principal investigator of several investigator-initiated studies regarding clinical markers and outcomes in peripheral artery disease and cardiovascular treatment in chronic kidney disease.
