## Speaker's Biosketch ICoLA 2024

## Jae Seung Lee (Yonsei University, Republic of Korea)

Jae Seung Lee is a hepatologist from South Korea. He earned his medical degree and PhD from Yonsei University College of Medicine. He completed his residency in Internal Medicine at Severance Hospital, and after completing a two-year fellowship, he has been serving as a clinical assistant professor since 2020. His research encompasses a wide range of topics in hepatology, with a particular focus on developing predictive models for hepatocellular carcinoma (HCC) in patients with chronic hepatitis B and metabolic dysfunction-associated steatotic liver disease (MASLD), as well as evaluating the diagnostic accuracy of non-invasive fibrosis measures. His numerous publications focus on the treatment and prognosis of patients with liver-related diseases. Additionally, he explores experimental topics such as the mechanisms of drug resistance in HCC using HCC organoids. He is an active member of the Korean Association for the Study of the Liver and the Korean Liver Cancer Association.
