Dr. Corral is an active member of the Red IberoAmericana de Hipercolesterolemia Familiar, the Lipid and Cardiology Societies of Argentina, and the European Atherosclerosis Society. He has published numerous papers in the field of lipidology and is a regular speaker at various cardiovascular meetings. Additionally, Dr. Corral is an expert in conducting phase 2 and phase 3 pharmacological trials and is a past president of the Argentine Lipid Society, further underscoring his contribution to medical research and clinical practice.
