Hoang Anh Tien (Hue University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Vietnam)

Dr. Hoang Anh Tien earned his Medical Doctor, Master of Internal Medicine, and PhD in Cardiology from Hue University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Vietnam. He is currently an Associate Professor at the same institution. Dr. Tien has an extensive career in medical education and research, having guided the graduation of 51 graduate students and 11 undergraduate students. He has also chaired significant scientific projects, including one under the Ministry of Education and Training, two provincial projects, and several at the university level.

With over a decade of experience in percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI) and pacemaker implantation, Dr. Tien has performed approximately 2,050 PCI procedures and 670 pacemaker implantations. His contributions to cardiology are further highlighted by his roles as the Vice Director of the Cardiovascular Centre at Hue University of Medicine and Pharmacy Hospital, Head of the Cardiology Department, and Head of the Digital Subtraction Angiography unit.

Dr. Tien is a Fellow of the European Society of Cardiology (FESC), the American College of Cardiology (FACC), and the Society for Cardiovascular Angiography and Interventions (FSCAI), among others. He also holds prominent positions in various Vietnamese medical associations (Vice President of Vietnam Atherosclerosis Society, Vice President of Vietnam Heart Failure Society), contributing significantly to the development of cardiovascular medicine in Vietnam. Dr. Tien has authored numerous international publications and textbooks, focusing on interventional cardiology, pacemakers, and sleep apnea syndrome. His dedication to advancing medical knowledge and improving patient care is recognized by several prestigious awards, including the Golden Globe Award for Scientific Research in 2012.
